Luxembourg Curling performs well in Cologne

Three Luxembourg teams travelled to Cologne over the weekend March 28th to take part in their Spring Tournament. A total of eighteen teams took part and all the Luxembourg teams performed well.

The top team was Lëtzebuerg 1, skipped by Yannick Hansen, who came fourth, losing one match only and that narrowly to the German National Seniors team who went on to win the tournament.

Team Broombastic, skipped by Jörg Moeser, played some very close matches to eventually finish in seventh place. Pride of place however goes to team Shamalaya, skipped by the veteran player Marc Hansen. The other Shamalaya players, Fabio, Furio & Francesco, had only been playing since January 2015, so their eleventh place was a fantastic achievement.
